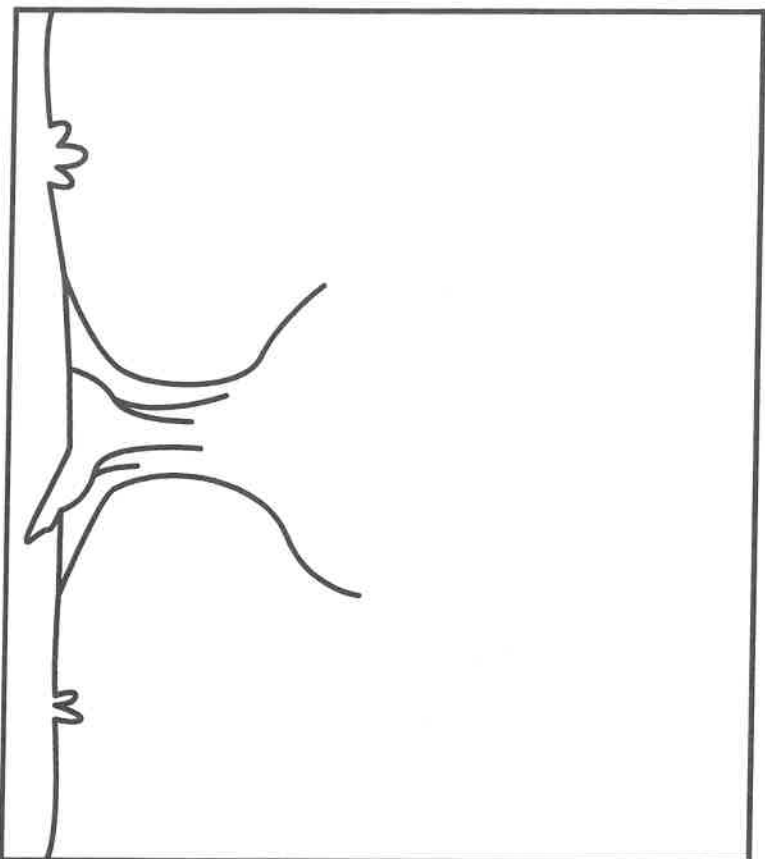


# FINISH the DRAWING

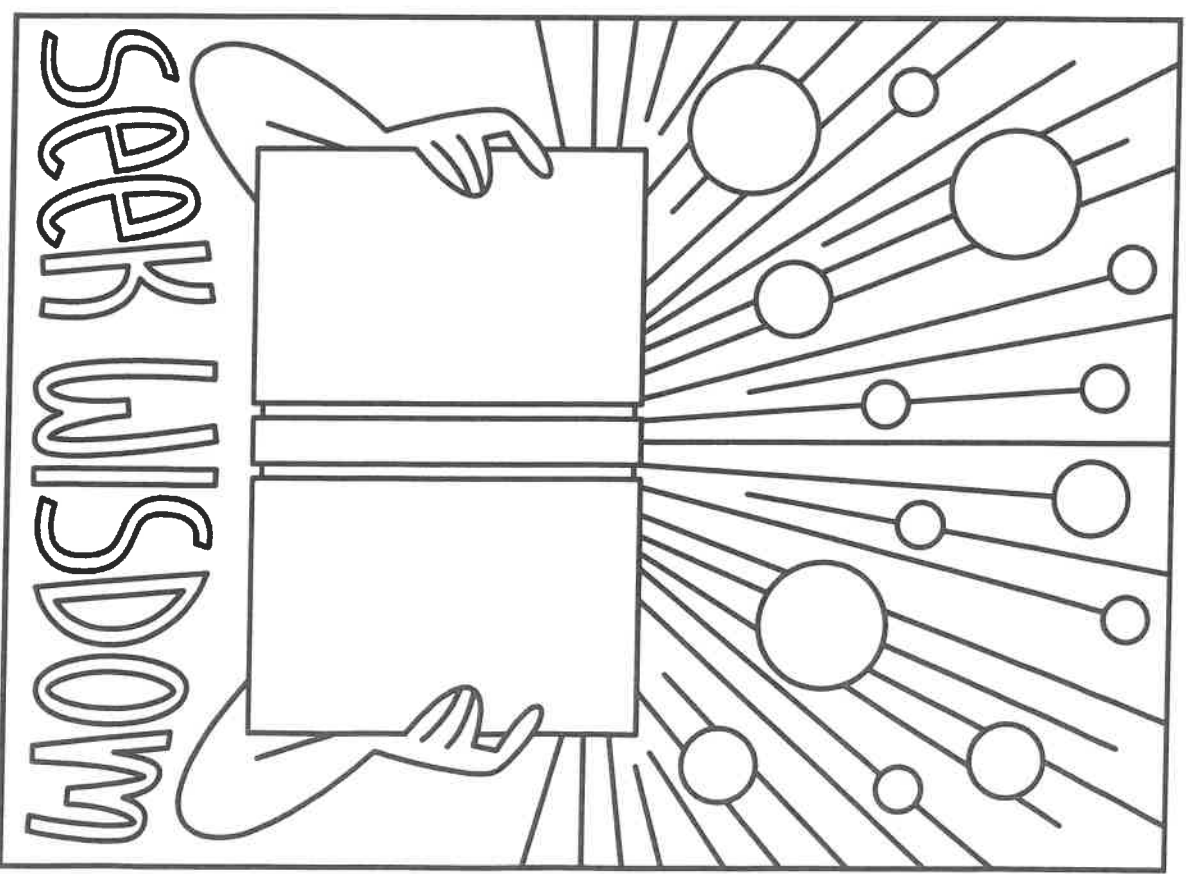



# CHILDREN'S WORSHIP • BULLETIN
