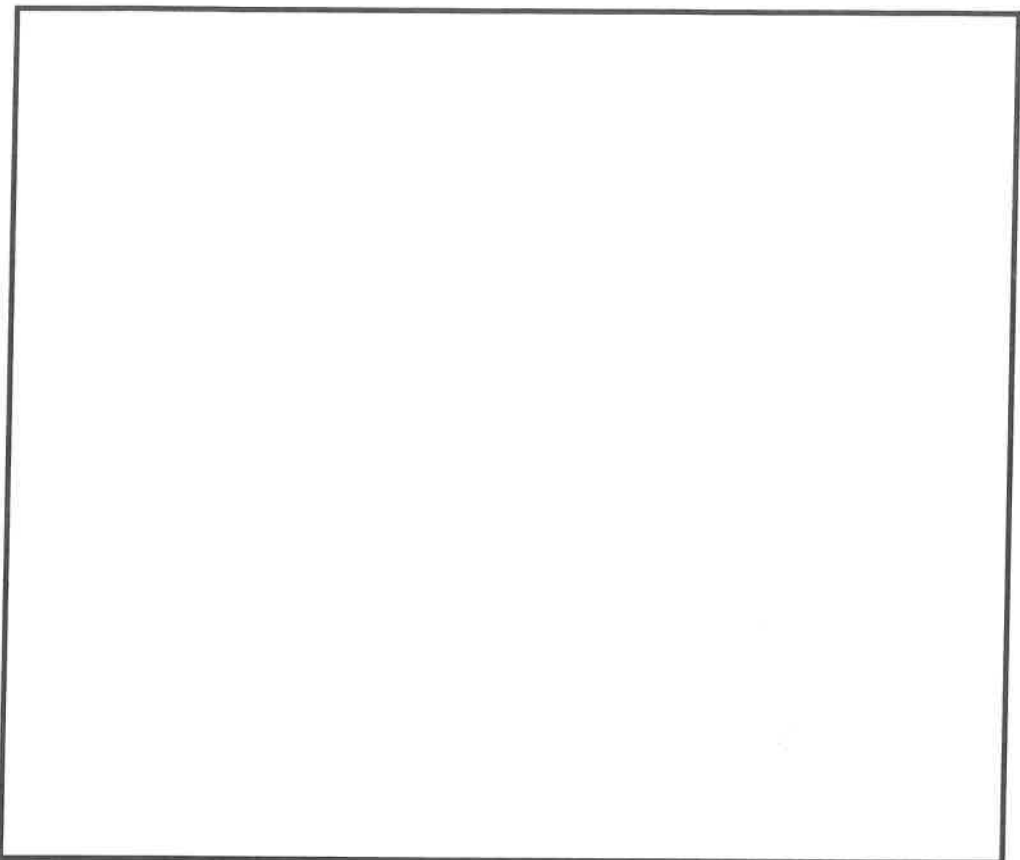




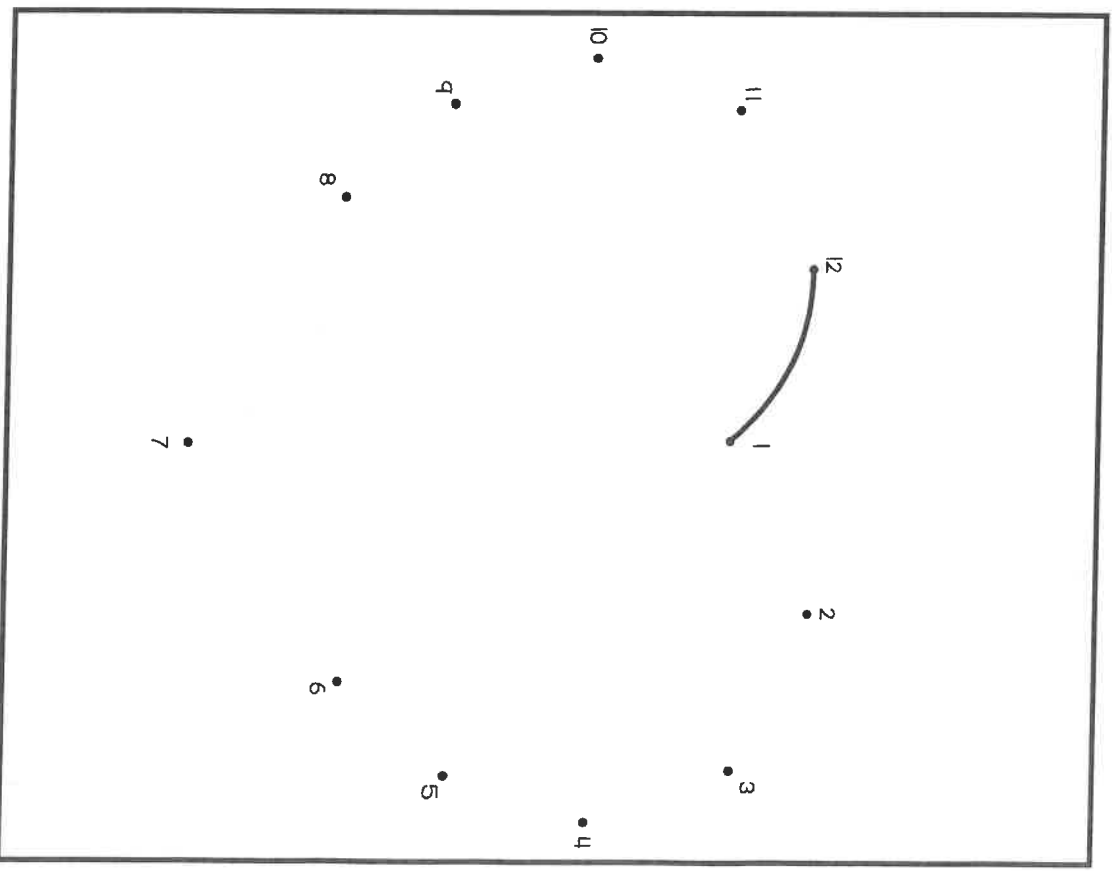
DRAW IT

CONNECT the DOTS

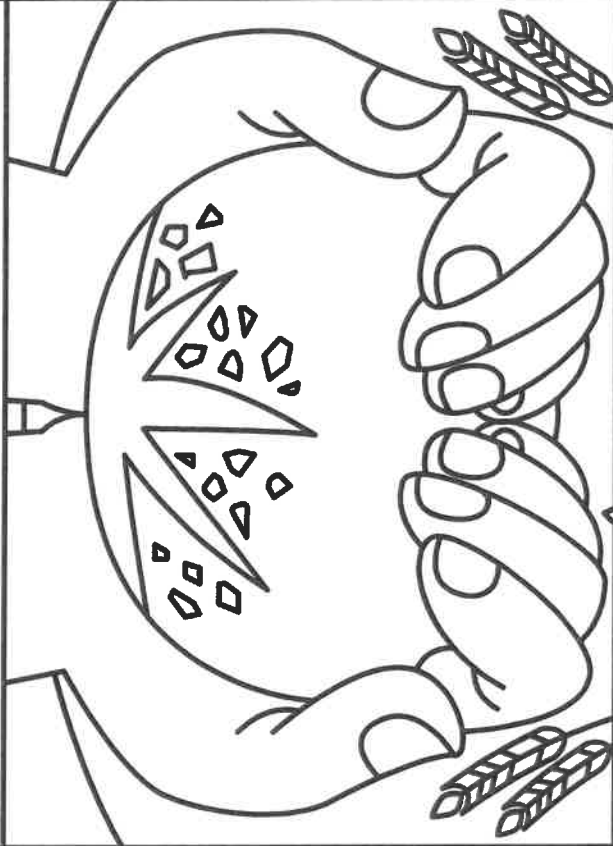

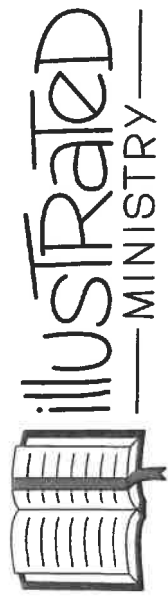
