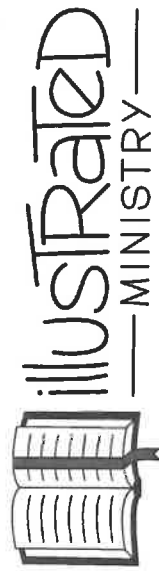
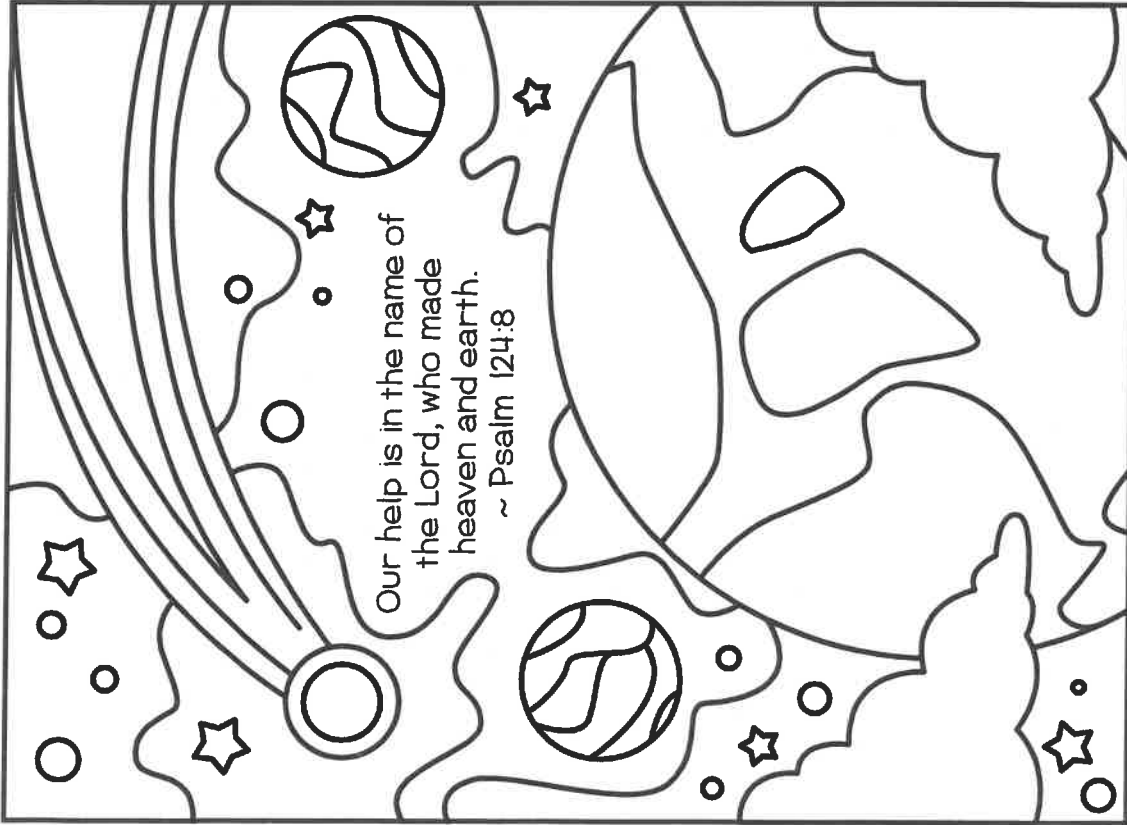
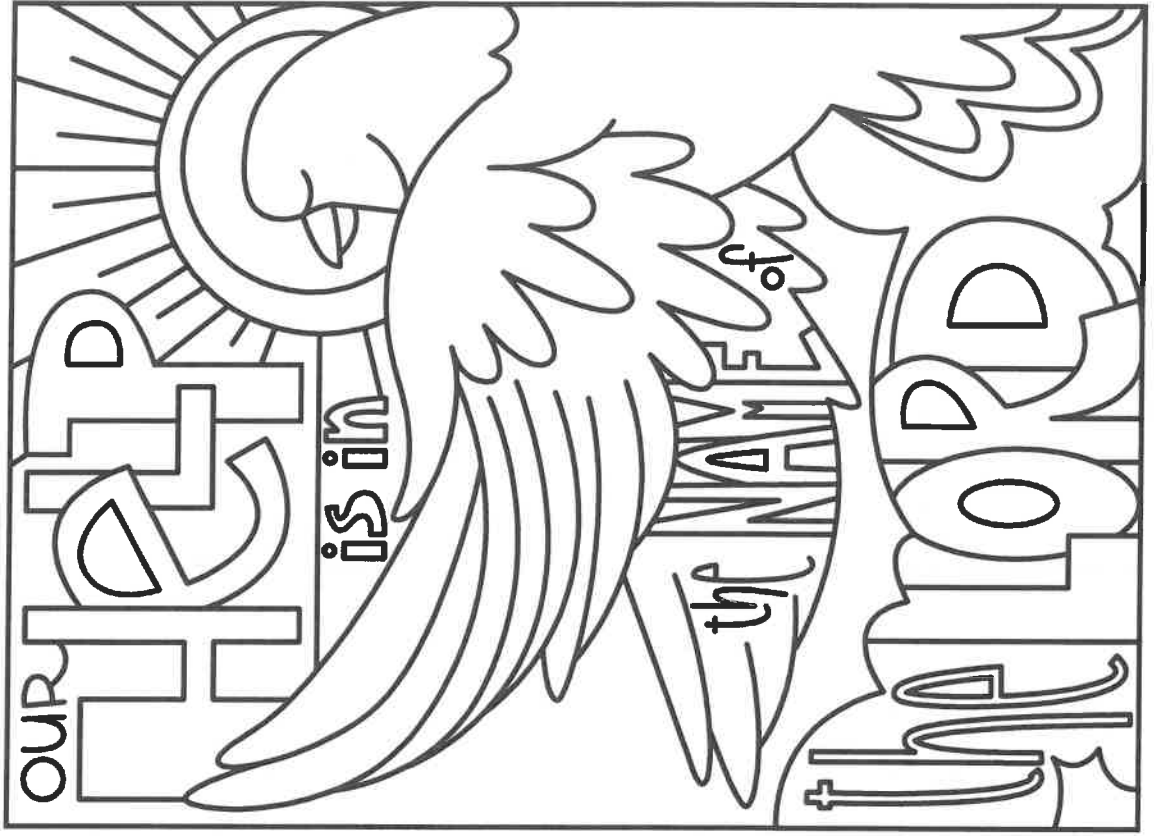

# DRAW IT

Esther shows us how to make the courageous choice, even when we feel afraid. She used what God had given her – especially her role as queen – to help as many people as she could. In Esther 7, she asks the king to protect the Jewish people even though this would make other leaders very upset. Esther knew God was with her in her risk. In the first box, draw what you imagine Esther looked like. In the second box, draw yourself doing something brave.

# SOLVE (the) MAZE

Sometimes, we get off-course and walk away from Jesus and what Jesus wants us to do. James 5 says that we are meant to help each other get back on track when this happens. Create a path through the maze to bring you and your friends back to close faith in Jesus.
