

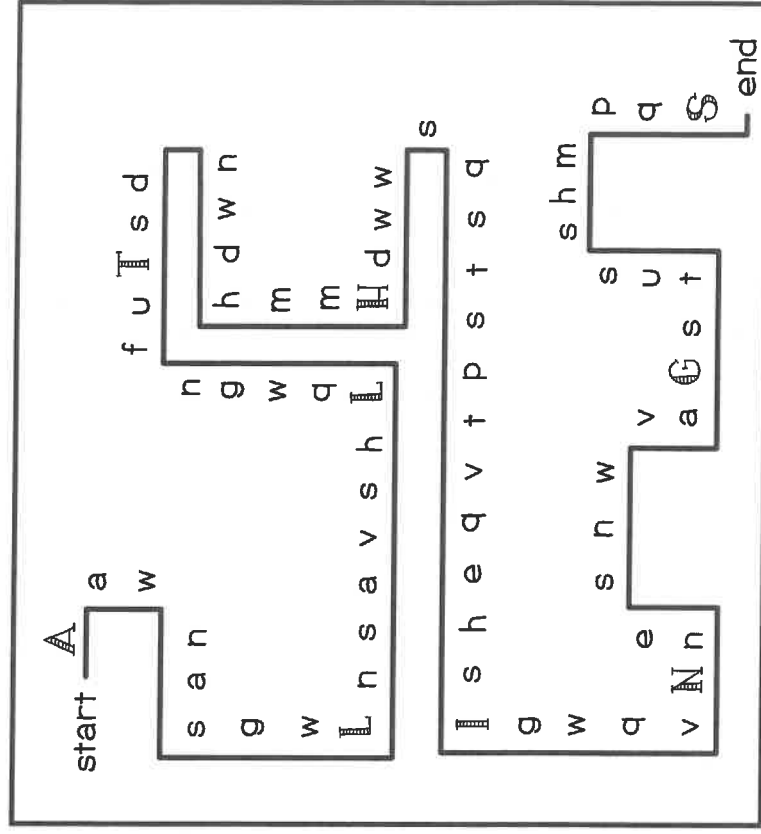


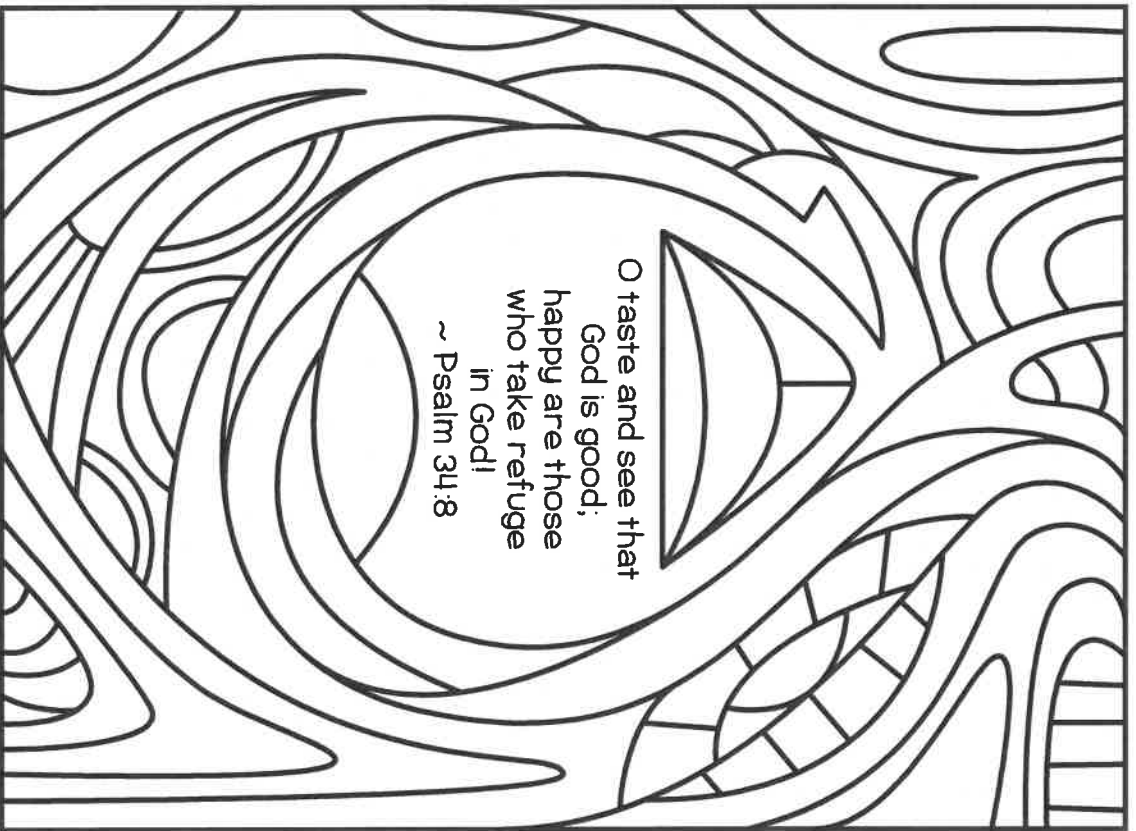
DRAW IT

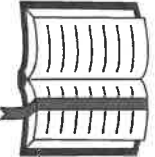
FOLLOW THE PATH

~ Psalm 34:8

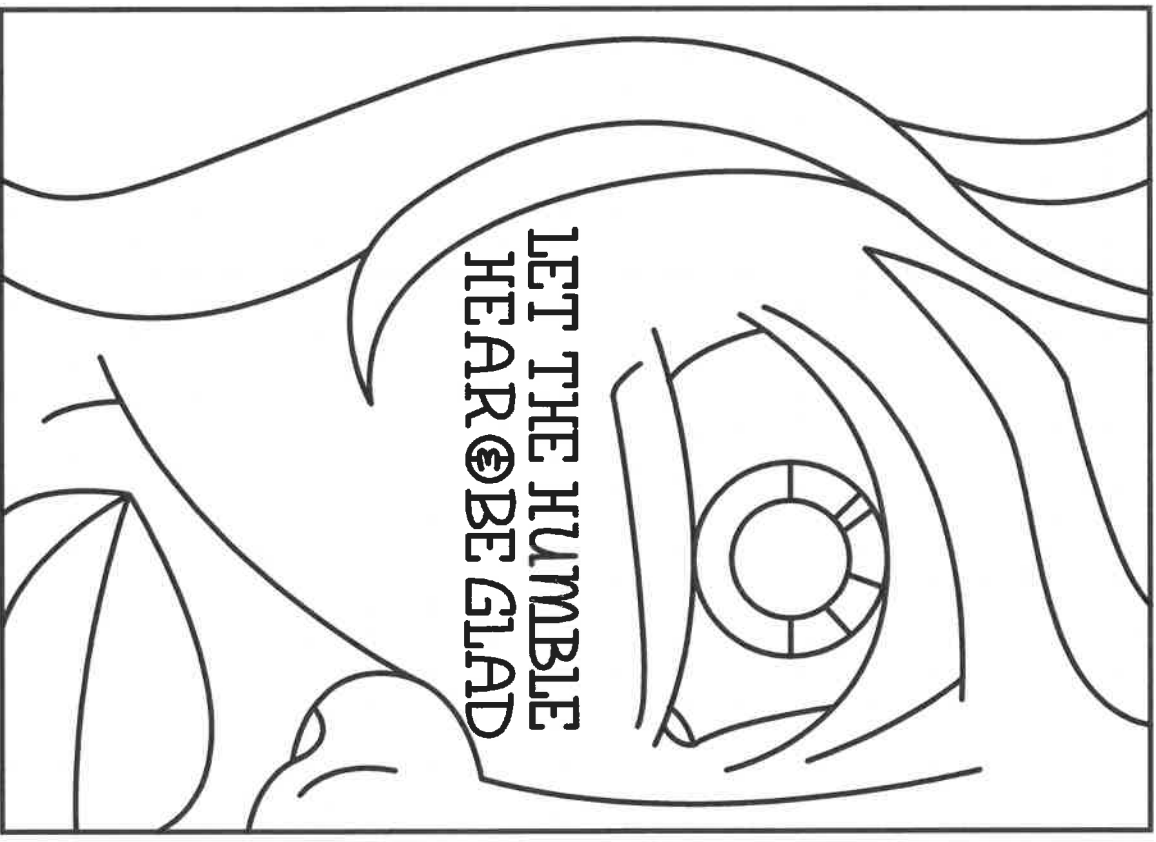
