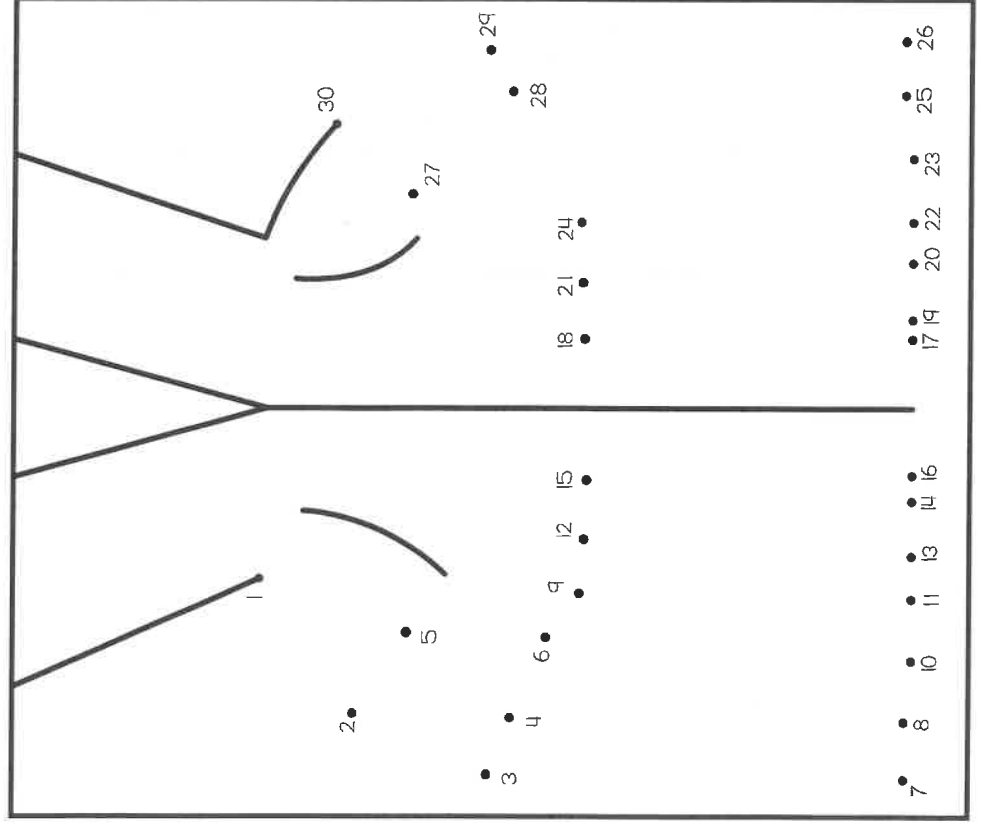


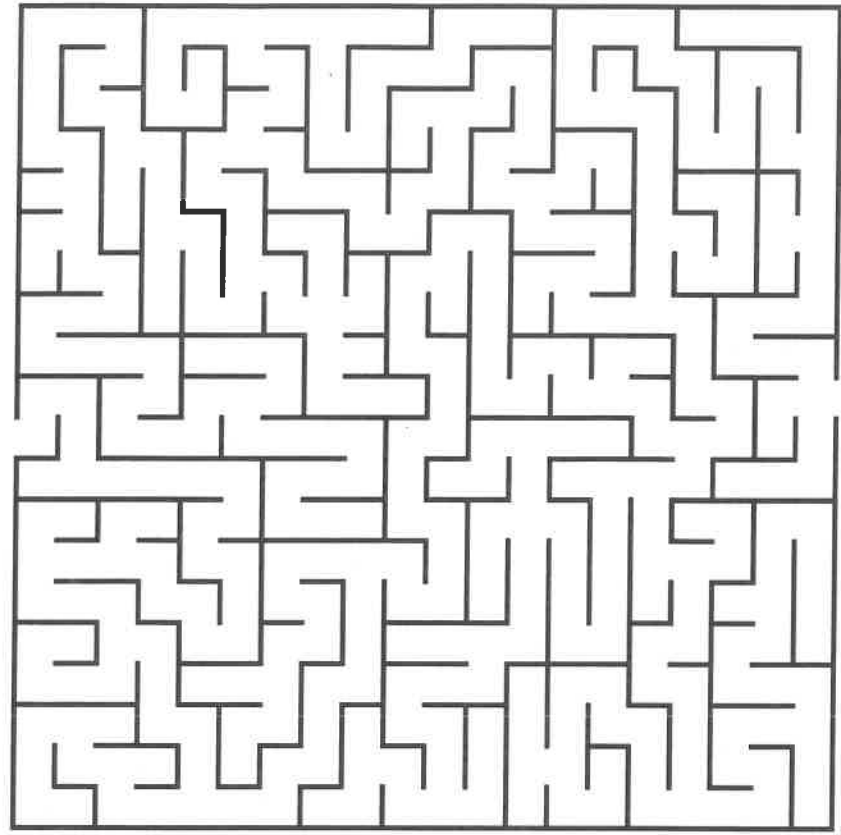
CONNECT the DOTS

SOLVE (the) MAZE

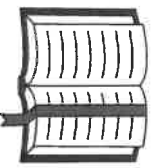
